**Genesis Colon, Alvin Hancock and Tyshon Myles Arraigned for
Death of 32-Year-Old Moran Wilson**

Rochester, NY- 22-year-old Genesis Colon, 29-year-old Alvin Hancock and 25 year-old Tyshon Myles were arraigned in front of Hon. Vincent M. Dinolfo after an indictment was unsealed in Monroe County Court. All three Defendants are charged with two counts of Murder in the 2nd Degree, one count of Kidnapping in the 1st Degree, one count of Burglary in the 1st Degree, one count of Robbery in the 1st Degree and one count of Robbery in the 2nd Degree. Genesis Colon and Tyshon Myles were also charged with Tampering with Physical Evidence. Genesis Colon was also charged with Criminal Possession of Marihuana in the Second Degree.

In May 2017, the Rochester Police Department located a body in the backyard of a Dayton Street home in the City of Rochester and identified the victim as 32-year-old Moran Wilson.

This case will be prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney David Dys, Chief of the Non-Violent Felony Bureau.

All three defendants are scheduled to appear June 28, 2017, at 9:30AM in front of State Supreme Court Justice Sinclair.
