Daniel Fuller Convicted of Rape in the Third Degree

Rochester, NY- Yesterday, a Monroe County Jury found 39 year old Daniel Fuller guilty of Rape in the Third Degree. On June 1, 2014, Daniel Fuller was on a first date in the City of Rochester with a 27 year old woman. Fuller had sexual intercourse with the woman after she made it clear she was not consenting to the act.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Elizabeth Buckley, Chief of the Sex Crimes Bureau.

"We applaud the courage of the victim as her testimony was instrumental in the prosecution of this case. This verdict reminds all of us that a woman never gives up her right to say no," said Assistant District Attorney Elizabeth Buckley.

Daniel Fuller will be sentenced by County Court Judge Christopher Ciaccio on March 23, 2016. Fuller faces a sentence of 2-4 years in state prison.
