**RE: ALDRICH ROAD – 2024 HIGHWAY, CULVERT, AND SIDEWALK PROJECTS**

Dear Neighbor:

Monroe County DOT will begin a shoulder reconstruction and widening project along Aldrich Road in early May. Shoulder work will be completed by the Town of Perinton Highway Department under an intermunicipal work agreement with Monroe County. Work this year will involve excavating and paving along the road edges to provide wider paved shoulders approximately five (5) feet in width on both sides.

Two-way traffic will be maintained during construction utilizing daytime lane closures with alternating two-way traffic; flaggers will guide traffic around the work areas. Access to driveways and side streets will be maintained at all times, except when work is occurring directly in front of these locations. In such instances, there may be a brief delay until flaggers indicate that it is safe to cross through the work zone. Mailboxes may need to be temporarily and/or permanently relocated as part of the shoulder work; Town crews will reinstall mailboxes in their permanent locations at the completion of shoulder widening.

Shoulder widening is anticipated to be completed by the end of May. This will be followed by utility work and replacement of the culvert over White Brook Tributary, which is anticipated to begin construction around the end of May. The culvert project will involve a full road closure on Aldrich Road; a separate construction newsletter with additional details regarding the culvert project and posted detour route will be sent at a later date. In addition, concrete sidewalks will be constructed on one side of Aldrich Road between Aldrich Glen and Piping Rock Run beginning later in the summer of 2024. Upon completion of shoulder widening, culvert replacement, and concrete sidewalk installation, we will return to treat the entire width of Aldrich Road in 2025 including the widened shoulders.

We apologize for any inconvenience that these projects may cause, and ask for your patience during construction.
