

**RE:** The Attorney General's Race and Certification of the Results of the 1998 General Election

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The lawsuit regarding the Attorney General's race prevents you from certifying the results of the race for Attorney General, however, the results of all other races should be certified according to the statute. *See*, Election Law § 9-214. This requires each county board to certify all offices by November 30 and the State Board's certification by December 15.

If you still have unopened ballots when you certify results on November 30th, the certification may be amended at a later date, since the Election Law provides that you may amend the certification of results once the court rules on the Attorney General's race. Election Law §9-218.
