Subject: Amend Resolution 207 of 2022, the Standard Work Day and Reporting Resolution for County Elected and Appointed Officials for Retirement Credit Purposes

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend Resolution 207 of 2022, the Standard Work Day and Reporting Resolution for County Elected and Appointed Officials for Retirement Credit Purposes.

The purpose of the amendment is to adopt the format for Standard Work Day and Reporting that is now required by the New York State and Local Retirement System. The time reporting information for elected and appointed officials in the proposed Resolution is the same as set forth in Resolution 207 of 2022 except that the proposed Resolution uses the new format and is updated to reflect the recent resignation of former Legislator Brian Marianetti and appointment of Legislator Kirk Morris.

This action is required by the New York Codes, Rules and Regulations, Title 2, Chapter VI, Part 315. The State regulations require that the Clerk of the Legislature post the Resolution on the County's website for thirty (30) days and file a certified copy of the Resolution with the Office of the State Comptroller within forty-five (45) days of its adoption.

The specific legislative action required is to amend Resolution 207 of 2022, the Standard Work Day and Reporting Resolution for County Elected and Appointed Officials for Retirement Credit Purposes.

This is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR §617.5(c)(26) ("routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

This action will have no impact on the revenues or expenditures of the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter receive favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
