I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend Resolution 387 of 2012, the Standard Work Day and Reporting Resolution for County Elected and Appointed Officials for Retirement Credit Purposes.

The purpose of this amendment is to: Update the reporting for the Monroe County Clerk, Cheryl Dinolfo, who began a new term on January 1, 2013; Change the reporting for the County Legislator for the 16<sup>th</sup> District, from Stephanie Polowe Aldersley to Dr. Joseph L. Carbone; Change the reporting for the County Legislator from the 17<sup>th</sup> District from Edward M. O'Brien to Joseph D. Morelle, Jr.; and to update the reporting for County Legislator Carrie M. Andrews, 21<sup>st</sup> District, and County Legislator Cindy Kaleh, 28<sup>th</sup> District.

This action is required by the Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York, Title 2, Chapter VI, and Part 315. The State regulations also require that the Clerk of the Legislature post the Resolution on the County's website for thirty (30) days and file a certified copy of the Resolution with the Office of the State Comptroller within forty-five (45) days of its adoption.
