Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize the attached transfer between the Pure Waters Administration Division and the Gates-Chili-Ogden Sewer District, Irondequoit Bay South Central Pure Waters District, Northwest Quadrant Pure Waters District and Rochester Pure Waters District to comply with the County financial system's new work order system.

This transfer is necessary due to the implementation of a new work order system within the County's financial system structure. The 2016 Adopted Budget included appropriations for contractual services within each District's budget. However, to accommodate the new work order system, which became fully functional in 2016, these appropriations must be moved to the Administration Division. This transfer will allow for contractual services to be expensed at the administration level and then charged back accordingly to each Pure Water's District based on work order activity.

Beginning in 2017, appropriations for contractual services will be budgeted in the Pure Waters Administration Division to accommodate this new work order system.


**The specific legislative action required is to authorize the attached transfer between the Pure Waters Administration Division and the Gates-Chili-Ogden Sewer District, Irondequoit Bay South Central Pure Waters District, Northwest Quadrant Pure Waters District and Rochester Pure Waters District to comply with the County financial system's new work order system.**

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

This transfer will have no net impact on the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter receive favorable action by Your Honorable Body.

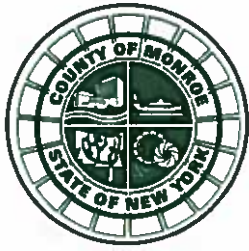

I recommend that the Administrative Boards of the Gates-Chili-Ogden Sewer District, Irondequoit Bay South Central Pure Waters District, Northwest Quadrant Pure Waters District and Rochester Pure Waters District ("Districts") authorize the attached transfer between the Pure Waters Administration Division and each of the four individual Districts to comply with the County financial system's new work order system.

This transfer is necessary due to the implementation of a new work order system within the County's financial system structure. The 2016 Adopted Budget included appropriations for contractual services within each District's budget. However, to accommodate the new work order system, which became fully functional in 2016, these appropriations must be moved to the Administration Division. This transfer will allow for contractual services to be expensed at the administration level and then charged back accordingly to each Pure Water's District based on work order activity.

Beginning in 2017, appropriations for contractual services will be budgeted in the Pure Waters Administration Division to accommodate this new work order system.

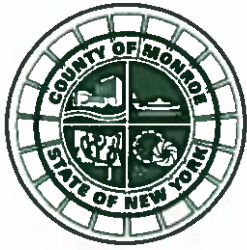

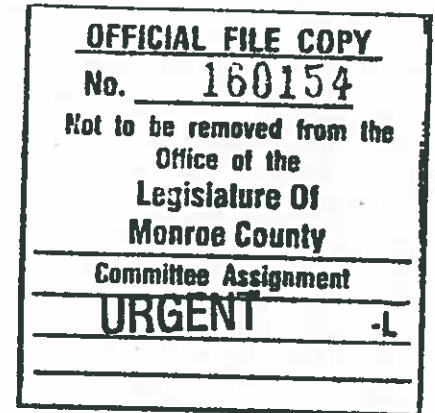
