Timothy Roland Brooks
Convicted of Attempted Robbery in the Third Degree

Rochester, NY- Today, a Monroe County Jury found 48 year old Timothy Roland Brooks guilty of Attempted Robbery in the Third Degree. On February 23, 2015 Brooks was observed loading goods into a grocery cart in Tops Supermarket on East Ridge Road in Irondequoit. Brooks left the store without paying for the items. When Tops Supermarket security attempted to apprehend Brooks with the stolen goods, an altercation ensued and Brooks escaped in his vehicle. Tops security was able to note his license plate number and shared it with the Irondequoit Police Department who traced it to one of his listed addresses.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Eric Hurd of the Non Violent Felony Bureau.

"As a repeat offender, Timothy Brooks faces significant jail time for his actions on February 23, 2015. Timothy Brooks has demonstrated an indifference to the law and lacks the ability to stay out of trouble," said Assistant District Attorney Eric Hurd.

Timothy Roland Brooks will be sentenced by Justice Thomas Moran on April 18, 2016.
