RESOLUTION NO. _____ OF 2020

APPROVING THE CONCLUSION OF HAZARD PAY DUE TO GREATER RISK OF EXPOSURE OR WORKING EXTENDED HOURS DUE TO THE COUNTY'S RESPONSE TO COVID-19 FOR CERTAIN CLASSIFICATIONS OF MONROE COUNTY EMPLOYEES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. Approving the conclusion of hazard pay for certain classifications of Monroe County employees authorized pursuant to Resolution 135 of 2020, as amended by Resolution 164 of 2020 and Resolution 203 of 2020, due to greater risk of exposure to COVID-19 and/or need for extended hours due to the County's response to COVID-19 by deleting Schedules "A", "B" and "C", and replacing them with Schedule "D," attached hereto.

Section 2. The payment of hazard pay for the classifications of employees deleted from Schedules "A," "B," and "C" by this Resolution shall terminate as of the last day of Pay Period 16, and only classifications of employees on Schedule "D" shall continue to be eligible to receive hazard pay beyond the last day of Pay Period 16. All hazard pay continued pursuant to this resolution shall terminate as of the earlier of the termination of the local State of Emergency regarding COVID-19 or December 31, 2020, unless otherwise approved by the Monroe County Legislature.

Section 3. Funding for this hazard pay will be 100% reimbursed through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act stimulus appropriation from the Federal government.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.
