Subject: Authorize Contracts with Adecco Medical & Science Staffing, Inc. and Reliant Staffing Systems, Inc. (DBA Career Start) to Provide Temporary Nursing Staff at a Crisis Rate of Pay During the COVID-19 State of Emergency at Monroe Community Hospital

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize contracts with Adecco Medical & Science Staffing, Inc. and Reliant Staffing Systems, Inc. (DBA Career Start), in a total amount not to exceed \$300,000 each, to provide nursing staff relief on a temporary basis at Monroe Community Hospital ("MCH") at a Crisis Rate of Pay, for the period of April 1, 2020 through the expiration or revocation of the State of Emergency issued March 17, 2020 and any renewals thereof.

MCH must maintain adequate staffing for patient care. This contract will provide for temporary relief services needed to cover absences due to COVID-19 illness, continuity of care to isolated residents, injury on duty, and job vacancies for certified nursing assistants, licensed practical nurses and registered nurses at the Hospital. The necessity of having a crisis rate of pay ensures that MCH will be a priority when the agency is assigning crucial staff to assure proper staffing levels are met at all times.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute contracts, and any amendments thereto, with Adecco Medical & Science Staffing, Inc., 1890 South Winton Road, Suite 180, Rochester, New York 14618 and Reliant Staffing Systems, Inc. (DBA Career Start), 350 East Avenue, Suite 205, Rochester, New York, 14604, in a total amount not to exceed \$300,000 each, for the period of April 1, 2020 through the expiration or revocation of the State of Emergency issued March 17, 2020 and any renewals thereof.

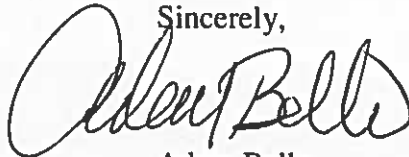
Funding for these contracts is included in the State of Emergency COVID Crisis Plan, fund 9001, funds center 1209070100 State of Emergency ~ COVID-19. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c) and is not subject to review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

The records in the Office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that neither Adecco Medical & Science Staffing, Inc. (a Publically Traded Company), Reliant Staffing Systems, Inc. (DBA Career Start), nor Lindsay McCutchen, owner of Reliant Staffing, Inc. (DBA Career Start), owe any delinquent Monroe County property taxes.

I recommend that this matter receive favorable action by Your Honorable Body.

AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS WITH ADECCO MEDICAL & SCIENCE STAFFING, INC. AND RELIANT STAFFING SYSTEMS, INC. (DBA CAREER START) TO PROVIDE TEMPORARY NURSING STAFF AT A CRISIS RATE OF PAY DURING THE COVID-19 STATE OF EMERGENCY AT MONROE COMMUNITY HOSPITAL

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute contracts, and any amendments thereto, with Adecco Medical & Science Staffing, Inc. and Reliant Staffing Systems, Inc. (DBA Career Start), in a total amount not to exceed \$300,000 each, for the period of April 1, 2020 through the expiration or revocation of the State of Emergency issued March 17, 2020 and any renewals thereof.

Section 2. Funding for these contracts is included in the State of Emergency COVID Crisis Plan, fund 9001, funds center 1209070100 State of Emergency – COVID-19.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.
