ACCEPTING GRANT FROM NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES FOR RAISE THE AGE LEGISLATION AND AUTHORIZING INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH ROCHESTER CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR ADMINISTRATIVE AND EDUCATION LIAISON PROVIDER WITH RAISE THE AGE YOUTH	
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:	
Section 1. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept a \$2,960,673 grant from, and to execute a contract and any amendments thereto with, the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services for the Raise the Age Legislation for the period of April 1, 2023 through March 31, 2024.	
Section 2. The 2024 operating budget of the Department of Public Safety, Office of Probation and Community Corrections, is hereby amended by appropriating the sum of \$561,383 into general fund 9300, funds center 2403020100, Juvenile Services Family Division.	
Section 3. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute an intermunicipal agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Rochester City School District for an Administrative and Education Liaison provider with Raise the Age youth in the amount of \$170,000 for the period of April 1, 2023 through March 31, 2024.	
Section 4. The County Executive is hereby authorized to appropriate any subsequent years of the grant award in accordance with the grant terms, to reappropriate any unencumbered balances during the grant period according to the grantor requirements, to make any necessary funding modifications within the grant guidelines to meet contractual commitments, and to enter into any amendments to extend the time period of the grant.	
Section 5. Should funding of this program be modified or terminated for any reason, the County Executive is hereby authorized to terminate or modify the program and, where applicable, to terminate or abolish some or all positions funded under such program. Any termination or abolishment of positions shall be in accordance with New York State Civil Service Law and, when applicable, the terms of any labor agreement affecting such positions.	
Section 6. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.
