ACCEPTING GRANT FROM NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND AUTHORIZING INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENTS FOR TOBACCO ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

- Section 1. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept a \$979,250 grant from, and to execute a contract and any amendments thereto with, the New York State Department of Health for the Tobacco Enforcement Program for the period of April 1, 2024 through March 31, 2029.
- Section 2. The 2024 operating budget of the Department of Public Health is hereby amended by appropriating the sum of \$195,850 into general fund 9300, funds center 5806010000, Environmental Health Administration.
- Section 3. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute intermunicipal agreements, and any amendments thereto, with the City of Rochester, the Towns of Brighton, Gates, Greece, Irondequoit, Ogden, and Webster, and other municipalities as necessary for the Tobacco Enforcement Program in a total amount not to exceed \$89,890 annually for the period of April 1, 2024 through March 31, 2029.
- Section 4. The County Executive is hereby authorized to appropriate any subsequent years of the grant award in accordance with the grant terms, to reappropriate any unencumbered balances during the grant period according to the grantor requirements, to make any necessary funding modifications within grant guidelines to meet contractual commitments, and to enter into any amendments to extend the time period of the grant.
- Section 5. Should funding of this program be modified or terminated for any reason, the County Executive is hereby authorized to terminate or modify the program and, where applicable, to terminate or abolish some or all positions funded under such program. Any termination or abolishment of positions shall be in accordance with New York State Civil Service Law and, when applicable, the terms of any labor agreement affecting such positions.
- Section 6. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.
