**Subject: Authorization to Dedicate the Roadway to the Clubhouse Located in Durand Eastman Park "Jim Carlucci Drive"**

Honorable Legislators:

We recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize the dedication of the roadway to the Clubhouse located in Durand Eastman Park "Jim Carlucci Drive."

Jim Carlucci holds club championships at all three of Monroe County's golf courses, having won Genesee Valley in 2012, Churchville in 2018, and Durand Eastman in 2007, 2011, 2019, 2020, and 2021. The 2023 opening day of golf was proclaimed Jim Carlucci Day, recognizing and celebrating Jim as one of the best local golfers. Jim was a long-time member of the Durand Eastman Men's Club and recently passed away from pancreatic cancer.

**The specific legislative actions required are:**

1. Dedicate the name of the roadway to the Clubhouse located in Durand Eastman Park "Jim Carlucci Drive."
2. Authorize the County Executive to take appropriate steps to effectuate the name change in an economical and reasonable manner.

This is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR §617.5(c)(26) ("routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

This authorization will have no impact on the revenues or expenditures of the current Monroe County budget.

We recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.

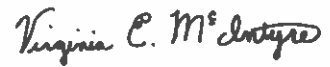

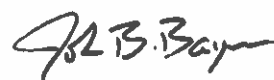

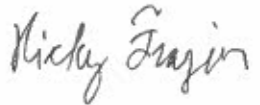
