Honorable Legislators:

I, Dr. Joe Carbone, President of the Monroe County Legislature, in accordance with Monroe County Resolution 361 of 1981, as amended by Resolution 23 of 1995, do hereby submit to this Honorable Body for your confirmation, the appointment of Mr. Richard Tantalo, Monroe County Director of Public Safety, as the County of Monroe Administration Representative to the 911 Operating Practices Board.

As Director of Public Safety, Chief Tantalo is responsible for multiple public safety service agencies including Probation, the Crime Lab, Emergency Management Fire & EMS Coordination and oversight of the 911 Emergency Communications system. Chief Tantalo will be appointed to serve a three year term on the Board from June 10, 2020 through June 9, 2023.

The specific legislative action required is to confirm the appointment of Mr. Richard Tantalo, Monroe County Director of Public Safety, as the County of Monroe Representative on the 911 Operating Practices Board, to serve a three year term from June 10, 2020 through June 9, 2023.
