## Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend Resolution 303 of 2021 to extend the time period for the New York State Office for the Aging Expanding Access to COVID-19 Vaccines via the Aging Network Grant Funding Program grant for one (1) year, through September 30, 2023.

This time extension will be used by the Monroe County Department of Human Services, Office for the Aging to provide funding to aging and disability service agencies to help increase vaccinations among older adults and people with disabilities through such activities as (including but not limited to): disseminating credible information about COVID-19 vaccines, identifying people who may need help getting a vaccine, and arranging for or providing transportation to vaccination sites. Monroe County initially received a one year grant in 2021 with effective dates of April 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022. New York State Office for the Aging has extended the grant period to September 30, 2023. This is a no-cost extension, which means no additional funding will be provided, and only the grant period will be extended.

The specific legislative action required is to amend Resolution 303 of 2021 to extend the time period for the New York State Office for the Aging Expanding Access to COVID-19 Vaccines via the Aging Network Grant Funding Program grant for one (1) year, through September 30, 2023.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(26) ("routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

This grant is 100% funded by the New York State Office for the Aging. No net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
