Subject: Authorize Contracts with MRB Group, Engineering, Architecture & Surveying, D.P.C. and Wendel WD Architecture, Engineering, Surveying & Landscape Architecture, P. C. for Pump Station Engineering Term Services

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize contracts with MRB Group, Engineering, Architecture & Surveying, D.P.C. and Wendel WD Architecture, Engineering, Surveying & Landscape Architecture, P. C., for a total annual amount not to exceed \$150,000 for each contract, for Pump Station Engineering Term Services for the Monroe County Department of Environmental Services, for the period of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year extensions, with escalations for the extensions to be limited to an amount equal to the increase in the previous year's Consumer Price Index (U.S. City Average CPI-U from the Bureau of Labor Statistics).

Monroe County Pure Waters owns, operates and maintains over sixty-two (62) sewage pumping stations throughout its four Districts. Pure Waters has implemented a program to inventory its pump stations and develop a long-term improvement program to maintain the reliability and continuity of its facilities. Pure Waters will utilize term engineering consultants to perform a variety of professional services including facility evaluations, analysis, recommendations and preparation of reports, plans, specifications and construction estimates and administration/inspection for pump station improvements.

Several consultants were considered, with MRB Group, Engineering, Architecture & Surveying, D.P.C. and Wendel WD Architecture, Engineering, Surveying & Landscape Architecture, P. C. rated the most qualified to provide these services.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to execute contracts, and any amendments thereto, with MRB Group, Engineering, Architecture & Surveying, D.P.C., 145 Culver Road, Suite 160, Rochester, New York 14620, and Wendel WD Architecture, Engineering, Surveying & Landscape Architecture, P. C., 85 Allen Street, Suite 200, Rochester, New York 14608, for pump station engineering term services for the Monroe County Department of Environmental Services, for a total annual amount not to exceed \$150,000 for each contract, for the period of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year extensions, with escalations for the extensions to be limited to an amount equal to the increase in the previous year's Consumer Price Index (U.S. City Average CPI-U from the Bureau of Labor Statistics).

No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.
