Subject: Amend Resolution 395 of 2015 to Accept Additional Funding from the New York State Department of Health for the Comprehensive HIV/STI/Hepatitis C Prevention, Particularly in Communities of Color Program

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend Resolution 395 of 2015 to accept additional funding from the New York State Department of Health, in the amount of \$10,845, for the Comprehensive HIV/STI/Hepatitis C Prevention, Particularly in Communities of Color Program, for the period of December 1, 2015 through November 30, 2016.

The purpose of this grant is to provide targeted outreach activities to heterosexual individuals in areas with high rates of sexually transmitted infections (STIs), HIV and Hepatitis C. This additional funding will be used to purchase equipment, medical supplies, and bus passes for clients. The additional funding will bring the grant total to \$224,100.

The specific legislative actions required are:


1. Amend Resolution 395 of 2015 to accept an additional \$10,845 from, and to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to execute a contract and any amendments thereto with, the New York State Department of Health, for the Comprehensive HIV/STI/Hepatitis C Prevention, Particularly in Communities of Color Program, bringing the total program award to \$224,100, for the period of December 1, 2015 through November 30, 2016.
2. Amend the 2016 operating grant budget of the Department of Public Health by appropriating the sum of \$10,845 into fund 9300, funds center 5802030200, STD Investigation & Prevention.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

This grant is 100% funded by the New York State Department of Health. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
