Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize an intermunicipal agreement with the City of Rochester Police Department to provide traffic control services for regular and post-season Red Wings baseball games at Frontier Field during the 2019 season at the rate of \$79 per hour for each Police Officer, in an amount not to exceed \$94,000, for the period of April 11, 2019 through September 23, 2019.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to execute an intermunicipal agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the City of Rochester Police Department, to provide traffic control services for regular and post-season games at Frontier Field during the 2019 baseball season at a rate of \$79 per hour for each Police Officer, in an amount not to exceed \$94,000, for the period of April 11, 2019 through September 23, 2019.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

Funding for this agreement is included in the 2019 operating budget of the Department of Finance-Unallocated, general fund 9001, funds center 1209060600, Frontier Field. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.
