IVHEREAS, Henry was born on June 23, 1947 in Williamsburg County, South Carolina. He was the Son of late Henry Burroughs, Sr. and Quessie Jenkins Burroghs. Henry was educated in the public school system of Williamsburg County. Earlier in his life, he worked in a coal mine in Utah and Kentucky. After moving back home to South Carolina, he worked at Martek Telephone and Wellman. He later retired and spent his time working on a farm; and
