Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend the Employment Policies for Management & Professional employees by increasing the maximum Flexible Time Bank accrual from five (5) days to fifteen (15) days as set forth in the Monroe County Employee Handbook - Management & Professional.

Monroe County greatly values its dedicated workforce during the COVID-19 crisis. Many Management & Professional employees have worked and continue to work above the allowed compensation levels set forth in the Monroe County Employee Handbook-Management & Professional. This amendment will allow the Management & Professional employees to accrue up to ten (10) additional days.

The specific legislative action required is to amend the Employment Policies for Management & Professional employees by increasing the maximum Flexible Time Bank accrual from five (5) days to fifteen (15) days as set forth in the Monroe County Employee Handbook - Management & Professional.

Honorable Legislators:

Pursuant to Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, I request that Your Honorable Body grant the County Executive the authority to authorize, enter into and execute any agreement or contract and any amendments thereto on behalf of the County of Monroe for goods and services needed to combat the COVID-19 virus in our community in which the total consideration thereof is \$150,000 or less.

In response to the Coronavirus disease that threatens our community, I issued a Local State of Emergency Proclamation on March 14, 2020 in order for the County to take appropriate steps necessary to deal with the health crisis. Section 24.4 of the New York State Executive Law authorizes the County Legislature to confer upon the County Executive additional duties or responsibilities as the Legislature deems appropriate to address the public emergency. In order to procure necessary medical, nursing and other health services required to respond to the threat of COVID-19 in Monroe County, I request that this Honorable Body increase the total contract amount that the County Executive may execute under Administrative Code § A5-6.A from \$20,000 to \$150,000 while a local State of Emergency is in effect.

The specific legislative actions required are:

- 1. Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to enter into and execute any agreement or contract and any amendments thereto on behalf of the County of Monroe for goods and services needed to address the COVID-19 virus in which the total consideration thereof is \$150,000 or less.
- 2. Within three days of the execution of any agreement or contract authorized under this action, the County Executive or his designee shall provide the Clerk of the County Legislature a copy of such agreement or contract.

3. The duration of this authorization shall be limited to the time during which a local State of Emergency is in effect, but in no event longer than 120 days from the effective date of this action unless otherwise approved by Your Honorable Body.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c) and is not subject to review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.
