Honorable Legislators:

This matter is being referred to Your Honorable Body at the request of Sheriff Todd K. Baxter.

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize an intermunicipal agreement with the Fairport Central School District for the purchase of fuel for Monroe County Sheriff's Office vehicles, for the period of September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2020, with the option to renew for three (3) additional one-year periods, at the rate of ten cents (\$.10) per gallon above the New York State contract price, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.

The Sheriff's Office has purchased gasoline from the other school districts in the past in an effort to reduce the time spent driving vehicles to fueling sites, thus increasing patrol coverage. This would be the 23rd year of this effort. This agreement would be consistent with other fueling agreements at the Sheriff's Office.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to execute an intermunicipal agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Fairport Central School District, for the purchase of fuel for vehicles of the Monroe County Sheriff's Office, for the period of September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2020, with the option to renew for three (3) additional one-year periods, at the rate of ten cents (\$.10) per gallon above the New York State contract price, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.
