Subject: Enact a Local Law Entitled "Regulation of Grease Trap Covers in Monroe

County"

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body enact a Local Law regulating grease trap covers in Monroe County. This local law shall be known and may be cited as Bryce's Law.

A recent tragedy has highlighted the need for greater regulation of the safety and security of the covers of "grease traps" or "grease interceptors" in our community. In the wake of the recent loss of an area child, it was revealed that no agency or entity, at the state or local level, is explicitly responsible for the ongoing inspection of grease trap covers in New York State.

While Monroe County has not been and is not responsible for the ongoing inspection and enforcement of grease trap manhole covers, it is unacceptable that there are not uniform standards for this type of infrastructure across New York.

Until Albany takes action to provide clear statewide law or regulation, it is imperative that Monroe County take the lead to address this ambiguity under the law. I am therefore introducing for your consideration a new Local Law that will require specific safety and security standards for grease trap covers in Monroe County, while also ensuring compliance through regular inspections.

The specific legislative actions required are:

- 1. Schedule and hold a Public Hearing on the proposed Local Law.
- 2. Enact a Local Law regulating the use of Grease Traps in Monroe County.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.
