This matter is being referred to Your Honorable Body at the request of Sheriff Todd K. Baxter.

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize an intermunicipal agreement with the Town of Henrietta for additional deputy coverage for selected targeted traffic enforcement, locations to be determined by the Town of Henrietta Town Supervisor, in an amount not to exceed \$9,110.08 for the period of August 1, 2020 through November 1, 2020.

Under this agreement, the Monroe County Sheriff's Office will provide a uniformed Deputy with a marked patrol car to conduct targeted traffic enforcement in the Town of Henrietta for a total of 112 hours.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to enter into an intermunicipal agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Town of Henrietta for additional deputy coverage for selected targeted traffic enforcement, locations to be determined by the Town of Henrietta Town Supervisor, in an amount not to exceed \$9,110.08 for the period of August 1, 2020 through November 1, 2020.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c) and is not subject to review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.
