Dear Neighbor:

Monroe County plans to replace the existing bridge carrying **Jacobs Road over Yanty Creek** during the 2026 construction season. This bridge is located approximately 0.6 miles to the east of Redman Road in the Town of Hamlin.

The existing bridge was originally constructed in 1910, extended in 1951, and has been inspected regularly. Due to its poor condition, a weight restriction has been posted for the bridge and it has been deemed by the Department to be near the end of its useful life. The bridge is proposed to be replaced with a new precast concrete structure.

Construction is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2026. During that time, Jacobs Road will be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic at the bridge site. There will be a posted detour around the closure utilizing Priem Road, Moscow Road, and Redman Road. Jacobs Road will be open to local traffic only up to the bridge work area, but it will not be passable.

The project is estimate to take approximately 4 months to complete. Additional correspondence will be sent out at least 2 weeks prior to the planned road closure in the spring of 2026.

Enclosed with this letter is an information sheet describing the project and the detour route. It also contains a link (with QR code) to submit comments or questions through an online form.
