Jacobs Road Bridge over  
Yanty Creek (BIN 3317670)

Town of Hamlin, Monroe County



**Project Description:**

The project proposes to replace the bridge that carries Jacobs Road over Yanty Creek in the Town of Hamlin. The project limits (including pavement and guiderail work) extend approximately 100 feet east and west from the center of the bridge.

**Existing Bridge:**

- Constructed in 1910 and extensively widened in 1951.
- Steel girder/floor beam superstructure with an open grate steel deck.
- 22-ft. clear span.

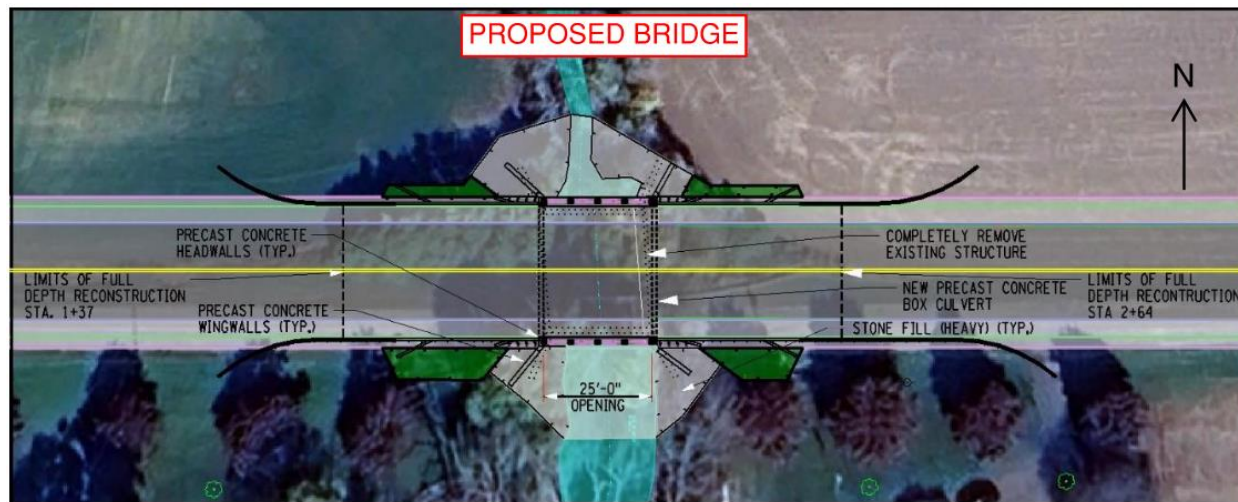
**Project Objective:**

Address structural and hydraulic deficiencies to meet current standards.

**Proposed: Bridge Replacement**

The proposed bridge replacement includes the following features:

- Complete removal of the existing bridge.
- Installation of a new 3 sided precast concrete bridge structure with 25-ft. clear span.
- Installation of precast concrete wingwalls at each corner of the bridge.
- Installation of four-rail bridge railing across the new bridge along with installation of new box beam guide railing.
- Placement of stone fill slope protection at the inlet and outlet of the bridge for prevention of erosion and scour.
- Full reconstruction 127-ft. of road at the location of the new bridge consisting of 11-ft. travel lanes and 6-ft. shoulders.
- Mill and resurface may be needed for a very short portion of road at each end of the reconstructed road section.
- Temporary relocation or shielding of overhead utilities may be needed during construction.



## Maintenance & Protection of Traffic:

- The project will require closure of Jacobs Road at the project limits and will utilize a posted detour.
- Traffic will follow a signed off-site detour for the duration of construction. Starting on the east – it would be Priem Rd to Moscow Rd to Redman Rd.
- The detour will be approximately 2.6 miles long.



## Schedule:

- Preliminary Design – Ongoing
- Final Design – Completion in 2025
- Construction Bidding – Fall of 2025
- Construction – Spring 2026 (with an expected 4-month duration)

## Funding:

The project is being funded by the Bridge New York Program.

## Right of Way:

- The acquisition of easements along portions of the properties adjacent will be required.
- The easements will be needed for construction of the bridge and for future maintenance of the bridge.
- Affected property owners will be contacted during final design.
