- ✓ Be a registered voter

- ✓ Have reliable transportation to your assigned poll site
- ✓ Attend a paid Training session
- ✓ Pledge to assist voters and uphold election law



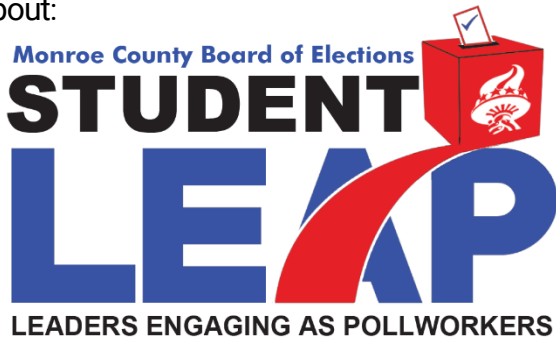

### Is this considered a legal absence from school?

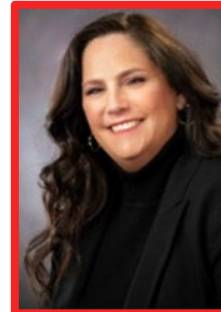
Yes! When you turn in a parent/guardian consent form you get a legal absence from school if you work on Election Day.

If so, you may need to update your voter registration to your new information if you haven't already (otherwise you'll have to vote by Affidavit Ballot on Election Day).

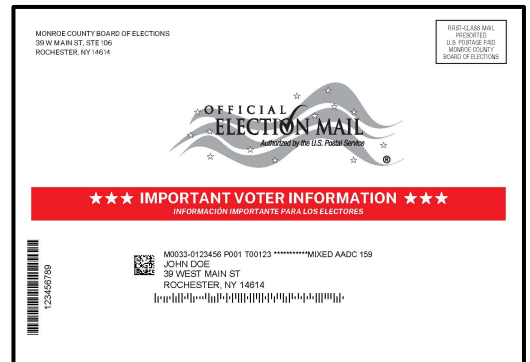

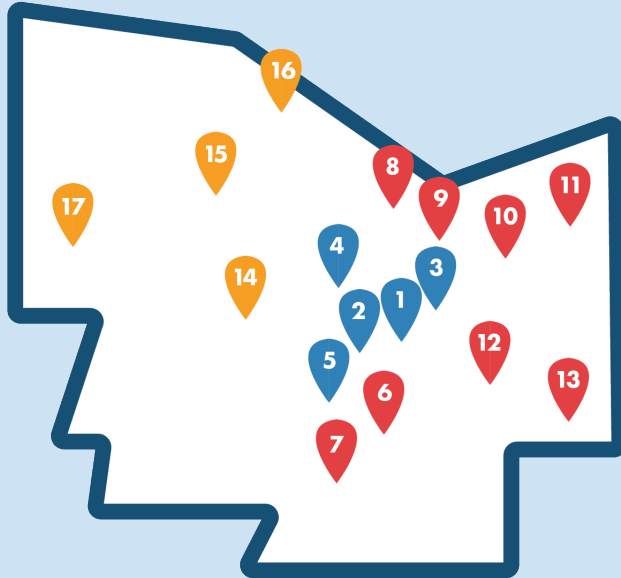
