"I know that finding time to apply for your passport can be difficult, especially for families. My office is very happy to offer these extended passport processing days during Spring Break to allow residents to apply for their passport outside of work hours without having to schedule an appointment. My office will continue exploring new ways to ease barriers for Monroe County residents and families wherever possible."
