


Although 47 homicides is far too many, I am pleased that the 2023 number is down nearly 19% compared to 2023 and down 38% compared to 2022. 47 homicides is the lowest number the City of Rochester has seen since 2019. I pray that this trend continues to decrease for our community.


Motor Vehicle Thefts

In 2025, we will continue to focus on huge increase of stolen motor vehicles in the City of Rochester, and throughout our entire community, over the past two years. Although we see a 47% decrease in these thefts compared to 2023, last year's number remains unacceptable. I will keep you updated on any felony indictments and the disposition of these cases.

These are the arrests for Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree that are not attached to homicide cases. While arrests are up compared the last year, shootings are down. To me, this means that we are successfully removing illegal firearms off the street, often before they are used in a homicide or assault.





Listed above is the percentage of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2^{nd} Degree arrests where non-monetary bail is being set at arraignments. I also noted the percentage of cases where cash bail was set at \$5,000 or less. Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2^{nd} Degree is a class C violent felony.

Youth Part Cases

There has been a lot of interest in youth part and juvenile prosecution. Listed below are the numbers we are seeing into Youth Criminal Part, and how many of those cases stay, or are transferred to Family Court, which is outside of our office.

Trials Next Week

The trial for the People vs. **Shavar Brooks** and **Miguel Clemons** begins on Monday, January 6. Both defendants are charged with Attempted Murder in the 2nd Degree, Assault in the 1st Degree, and two counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree in front of Monroe County Court Judge Dollinger.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Adam VanHeyst, of the Non-Fatal Shooting Taskforce, and Assistant District Attorney Jonathan Jirik, of the Vehicular Crimes Bureau.

The trial for the People vs. **Kevin Williams** begins on Monday, January 6. The defendant is charged with Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Walsh.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Merrick Sadler, of the Non-Fatal Shooting Taskforce.

The trial for the People vs. **James Spivey, Jr.** begins on Monday, January 6. The defendant is charged with Robbery in the 1st Degree and Robbery in the 3rd Degree in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Argento.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Aliyah Fowler, of the Major Felony Bureau.

The trial for the People vs. **David Lee Porter** begins on Tuesday, January 7. The defendant is charged with Murder in the 1st Degree, two counts of Murder in the 2nd Degree, two counts of Attempted Robbery in the 1st Degree, two counts of Robbery in the 1st Degree, Robbery in the 2nd Degree, and two counts Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Healy.

This case is being prosecuted by First Assistant District Attorney Perry Duckles.
