Breeze will serve four new destinations including non-stop flights to Raleigh, N.C and Charleston, S.C.

ROCHESTER, NY — Monroe County Executive Adam Bello today announced that Breeze Airways will begin service from the Frederick Douglass Greater Rochester International Airport (ROC) this spring. The newest airline in the ROC portfolio, Breeze will begin service to four destinations twice a week with nonstop flights to Charleston, SC (CHS) and to Raleigh, NC (RDU) beginning in May, 2025. The new routes will also include the company's BreezeThru service, allowing passengers to stay on the same plane and continue to New Orleans (MSY) or Orlando (MCO).

The airline features a modern fleet and customer-friendly service, making it a popular option among travelers looking for a high-quality and affordable experience. Expanding the company's route system to Rochester is a testament to ROC's growing reputation as a top ten small airport.

- Orlando, Fla. (One stop/no change of plane BreezeThru service, Mondays and Fridays, starting May 9).

"Flying local, Flying ROC is more important than ever," **said ROC Airport Director Andy Moore**. "The more passengers fly from home, the more the airlines take notice and increase the non-stop routes from ROC."
